It started to rain hard.

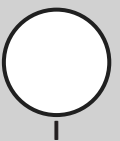

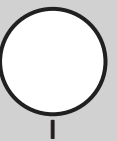
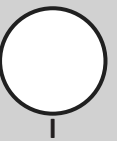
